All entries to be exhibited in the Poultry Pavilion, Royal Showground, on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday of Show Week. Committee reserve the right to accept or reject any entries or persons to the Pavilion.

GATE PASSES – Your entry form will allow vehicle entry to pavilion up to 9.00pm Tuesday of Show week. However exhibitors wishing to deliver birds on Wednesday prior to 8.30am will need to present an official vehicle delivery gate pass. Exhibitors will be issued with ONE WEDNESDAY “DELIVERY OF EXHIBIT PASS” - VEHICLE TO BE OFF GROUND BY 8.30 AM WEDNESDAY & ADMIT AFTER 4.00 P.M. ON SATURDAY FOR COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS.

AUCTION OF BIRDS: Birds must be entered in a nominated catalogue class. All auction entries to be marked with the letter A beside class number.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

- Prizes will be open for general competition. Entry fees must accompany certificate of entry. Members' privileges will not apply to entry fees in the Poultry Section.
- All entries must be made on the RAST official entry form. The Poultry Committee, in the event of such action being deemed necessary, reserves the right to limit entries in any Class.

- The Committee is empowered to exclude any bird which is not in a fit state for exhibition, either from disease or any other cause; the entry fee on such bird will be forfeited.
- All birds must be delivered to the Showgrounds before 9.00p.m. Tues. or before 8.30a.m. Wed., or they will be too late for competition. Judging will commence 9.00a.m. Wednesday. The Committee provides coops for all classes of poultry & feeds & attends to the exhibits during the Show. All eggs laid will be destroyed. The Pavilion will be opened to the public until 7.30 p.m. Friday.
- The Committee will be most anxious for the care and safety of the poultry sent for exhibition or any other property entrusted to them, but it must be understood by Exhibitors and all other persons that the Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any of the poultry or other property, arising from accident or other cause whatever, or from any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants or others.
- No one will be admitted during Judging to the portion of the building occupied by poultry, except Committee, Judges & Stewards.
- During the Show, exhibits will be in the custody of the Committee, and may not be touched or handled by the owners or any unauthorised person, under any circumstances.
- The age of all birds exhibited as young stock, under 12 months old, to count from 1st June of the year preceding the Show. It is desirable that ages should be stated as far as known. Any false statement will nullify all claims on the Society.
- The term Cock shall mean all male birds over 12 months old on 1st June preceding the Show. Cockerel, all male birds 12 months old or under on 1st June preceding the Show. Hen, all female birds over 12 months old on 1st June preceding the

- Show. Pullet, all female birds 12 months old or under on 1st June preceding the Show.
10. All protests must be lodged, in writing, with the CEO, no later than noon on Thursday of Show Week, and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50, which deposit shall, if the protest be deemed frivolous, be forfeited.
 11. The Committee reserves the right to substitute a Judge or Judges where necessary. In the event of more than one Judge being appointed, the Committee reserves the right, upon completion of judging, to appoint a recognised adjudicator, who will decide the winner of the Champion Exhibit in the Show.
 12. **AUCTION OF BIRDS**
No birds to be offered for auction unless entered in a nominated catalogue class. Birds to be AUCTIONED after 9 a.m. SATURDAY OF SHOW ONLY. All auction entries to be marked with the letter A beside class number.
 13. In the event of excessive entries, Committee reserves the right to reduce the number of birds in any class.
 14. **No Exhibit may be removed before 4 p.m. Sat. and all must be removed before 5 p.m.** Exhibits may only be removed in the presence of a Steward. An exception to this rule will be made with exhibits from Northern districts and at the discretion of the Show Manager. Exhibits can be collected Sun. between 9 a.m. 10 a.m., please make arrangements with Show Manager.
 15. Showing of birds with fixed metal leg bands will be permitted.
 16. In addition to any special regulations herein all Exhibitors in this section are subject to the General Regulations for Competitors and Exhibitors of The Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania, copies of which are available on request from the Society.
