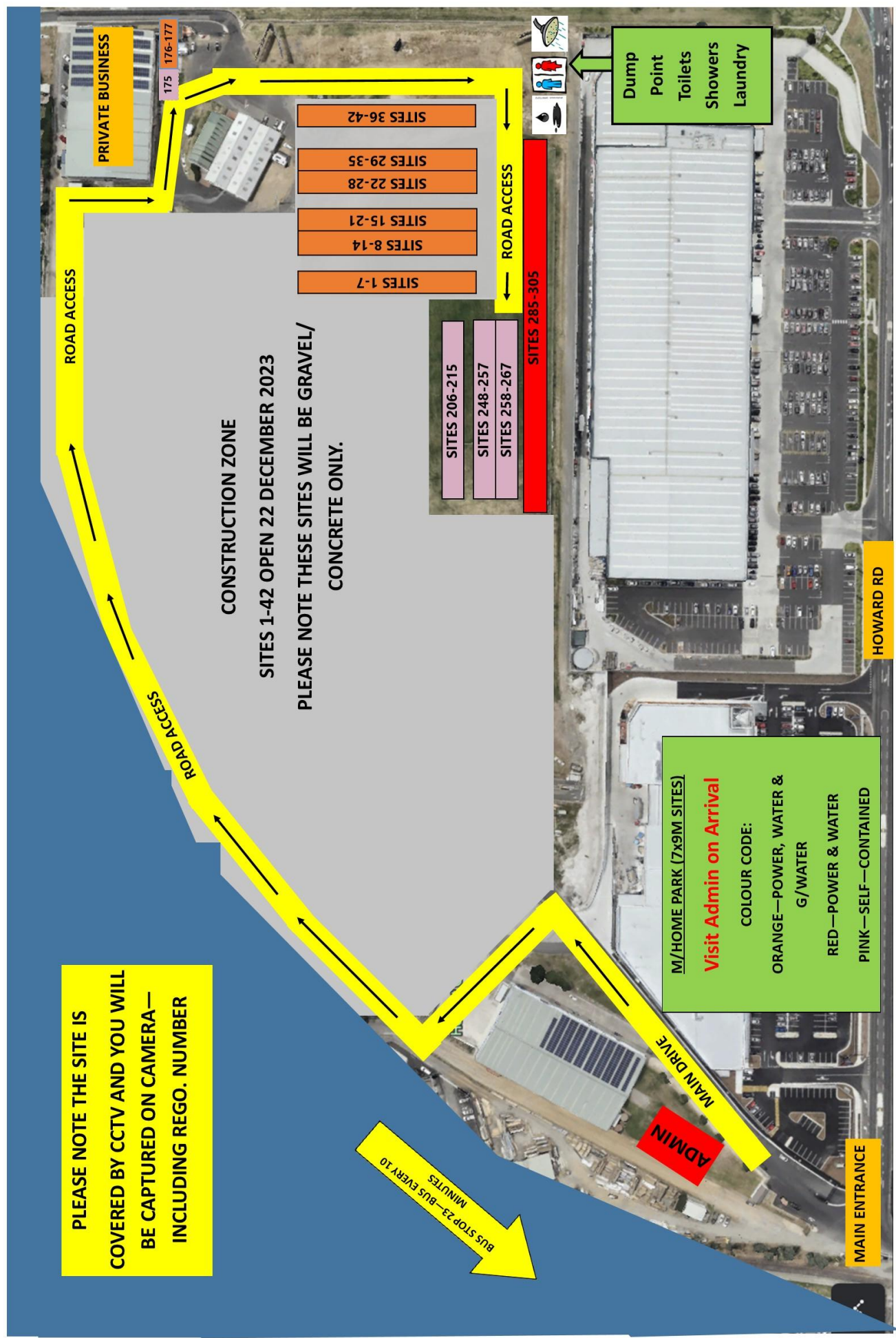

Code of Conduct / Conditions of Use

The Hobart Showground is operated by the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania (est. 1821). We are a not-for-profit entity not supported by any Government or Council. All money raised by us is spent on improving our grounds and presenting quality events that showcase agriculture.

Our motorhome park is open but please be advised that we are currently in our redevelopment phase. Our new sites (Numbers 1-42 on the booking system), will open on 22 December 2023 however they will be on a mixture of concrete and gravel surface due to construction delays. This may lead to increased dust in certain weather conditions, please contact us if this is of concern.

- You are required to display your camping permit so that it is clearly visible, on your dashboard or attached to your vehicle. Visitors should camp in designated areas only.
- Parking at the Royal Hobart Showground Motorhome Park is at your own risk. RAST accepts no liability for any damage that may occur to your property whilst onsite.
- Dogs should be kept on a leash when not in your own motor home. They should always be kept on a leash when being exercised and be sure to remove and thoughtfully dispose of any droppings. (please refer to the Glenorchy City Council publication, "Your Dog and the Law")
- Generators can cause noise and smell, please use discretion when using generators.
- For the comfort of other campers and our permanent neighbours please keep noise levels to a respectable level.
- **All powered sites may only access one power lead unless approved by RAST senior staff.**
- There is to be no fixed permanent or semi-permanent infrastructure installed on your site unless approved by the RAST CEO or Operations Manager. This includes any item or structure affixed to the walls of buildings, fences etc.
- Keep your laundry within the confines of your vehicle or awning, no washing is to be hung on the public road or main highway side of your vehicle or on fences around the grounds.
- A dump site is provided for discharge of grey and black water on arrival or departure, please do not discharge any grey water on the ground.
- As per standard CMCA practice a full bucket of water should be placed beside your vehicle.
- Dispose of rubbish and waste in the allocated wheelie bins or skip bins.
- Adhere to all speed limits and traffic signage within the site – 10 km per hour.
- Adhere to general signage & instruction from authorized RAST staff on site, your courtesy would be appreciated. Be aware that there are other users including pedestrians and animals. **Bad behaviour, foul language, abuse, intimidation or any other discourteous behaviour will not be tolerated.**
- **Vehicle repairs are not permitted on the grounds without the prior approval of management.**
- Refunds will generally not apply and are entirely at the sole discretion of management; Refunds, if allowed, will attract a \$20 administration charge
- If you arrive outside office hours (Mon-Fri 8.30am-5pm) please make an online booking.
- Check out time is 10.00am. If you intend to extend your stay, please see the administration office the day before your departure date. As we operate an online booking system, your site that you currently occupy may be already pre-booked.
- RAST reserves the right to move your booking onto a separate site if required and will endeavour to provide you as much notice as possible if this is to occur.

FAQ's / General Information

Bus from Showgrounds to Hobart City information

- The nearest bus stop to the Motorhome Park is bus stop 23.
- To get to bus stop 23 - walk to the gate entrance located on Howard Rd. Walk across the train line to your right. Continue up the laneway until you see the building with the car company ad on your right. The bus stop is located directly in front of this shop.
- Buses operate on a stop and go system so you must wave any city bound bus down, to have it stop for you.
- Buses do take cash and the fare is approx. \$3.20... be sure to have about \$4 in change.
- Buses to the city run Monday to Friday on 10 intervals, from 6.00am until 11.00pm.
- On Saturday busses run every 20 minutes from 6.12am until midnight
- On Sunday/public holidays busses run every 30 minutes from 7.05am until 9.05pm.
- If you catch the bus all the way into the CBD, you will be dropped in Collins Street, in the main shopping mall. A short walk towards waterfront will bring you to the information centre.

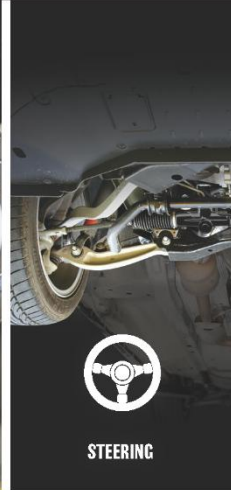
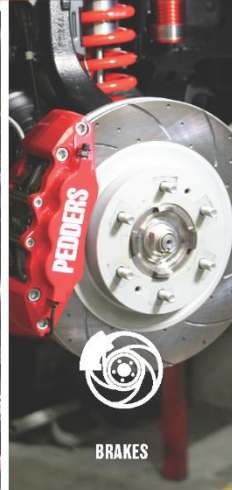
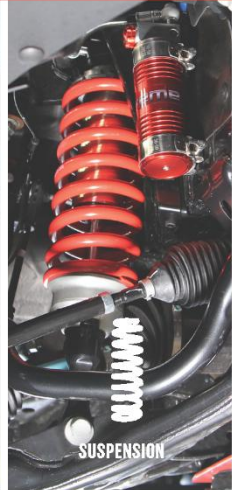
