The safety induction portal is compatible with tablets and ipads, Macintosh Computers and Personal Computers.

Can you please forward this information onto any of your staff, volunteers, workers and stakeholders attending the venue for the event to allow them time to complete this important safety process.

Although we are some months away from the event commencement. We view this process an important part of your WH&S site specific training for entering the site and fulfils the obligations required by all PCBU's under the current Work Health and Safety Act 2012.

Use the following link to access the training portal. At the successful completion of the assessment, details will be sent to the RAST Administrator and an induction card will be sent to each inductee's nominated email address.

Your induction card must then be printed out, signed and carried with you at all times whilst onsite for the event.

We encourage your staff and stakeholders to complete this process early to ensure that they have no issue with accessing the venue during the move in or out phases of the event.

Hi visibility vests must also be worn during the move in and out phases of the event and a current induction card must be available upon request or access to the venue may be denied until the issue is rectified.

This show is run under the breed standards of the Australian Cat Federation (inc.) and rules of the Tasmanian Feline Association (inc.).

This show will be run on the "OPEN" format - thus enabling interested exhibitors to observe the judging. **The cat pavilion will be open to limited general public access whilst judging in progress.** Exhibits must not be removed from the show hall before the close of show.

Sashes and Trophies will be awarded for Best and Reserve in show.

Presentation of Awards & Trophies - Exhibitors please note that trophies will be presented at approximately 3.30pm.

DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS:

Exhibits to be delivered between the hours of 7.00am - 7.45am Any vehicle remaining on the grounds after 8.00am will be towed away at the expense of the exhibitor. Cat Stewards will be on hand to accept exhibits and to ensure the cars are re-directed from the grounds. **Parking is available in the Public Show Car Park at Macquarie Point (adjacent to the Goods Shed).**
One gate pass per exhibitor will be issued. Multiple entries in joint names will receive two gate passes.

COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS:

Exhibitors will be permitted vehicle access to the grounds and Cat Pavilion from **4:30pm**.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Registration:

The Society may only accept entries for cats which are registered with a recognised control body. Companion Pets are exempt from registration.

Entry Fees: All Entry Fees must be paid at the time of entry.

Veterinary examination:

A suitably qualified veterinary official elected by the show committee, or the R.A.S.T. (inc.), shall examine each exhibit. They shall refuse to allow any cat to enter the exhibition if, in their opinion, it is suffering from any contagious or infectious disease or has external parasites, or which has been treated or prepared for exhibition in contravention of the rules and regulations under which the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania runs this event. The veterinary officer's decision in this regard shall be final. Should the veterinary officer reject an exhibit for reasons of contagious or infectious disease or evidence of external parasites, all that exhibitor's entries may be rejected at the discretion of the veterinary officer. No person may present an exhibit which has been exposed to the risk of any infectious or contagious disease during the period dating at least 12 days prior to the exhibition. It is expected that all exhibits should have appropriate immunisations prior to the show.

Benching:

Curtains (coloured/white) are allowed during judging and, if required, a hot water bottle completely enclosed. Litter trays to be preferably plastic and rectangular in shape. No foodstuffs are allowed in cages before completion of judging. Cages must be kept clean by exhibitors. One small toy per cage is permissible.

Withdrawal of entries:

When a person withdraws a cat entered in the Royal Hobart Show, they shall be required at the time of withdrawal to furnish a written explanation to the Show Secretary, or Show Manager. Where written explanation is not produced, or the RAST considers the explanation to be unsatisfactory it may request a Veterinary Certificate of clearance within 7 days, naming the withdrawn exhibits. Where a certificate is requested and not produced within 7 days, the person(s) concerned shall be considered as being in enforced quarantine by the controlling body under whose rules and regulations the show is held until such time as the certificate is produced.

Judging:

At the time of judging no person shall be allowed in the judging area save the judges and the properly appointed officials and stewards.

A judge's decision on the merit of the exhibit shall be final unless such decision is contrary to the rules and regulations under which the RAST show is held. Judges are empowered and instructed not to award any prize, challenge or award certificate to any exhibit which they consider is not of sufficient an award. Any exhibit which cannot be taken from its cage by the judge or steward will not be judged.

Owner's risk:

The care and safety of all exhibits, or any other property entrusted to it, is of the utmost importance to the RAST. However it must be understood that the RAST will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any exhibit or property, whether arising from accident, or other cause whatsoever, or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents servants or others.

Exhibits claws:

All Exhibits must have **clipped claws**, clean ears and coats free from pests. Strict attention must be paid to this rule. Claws are not to be clipped within the show hall.

THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED

A Bio-hazard Notice from The Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania.

The R.A.S.T. (Inc.) does not endorse the use of any behavioral altering or enhancement medications prior to judging regardless of the form in which it is administered.

Nor shall any form of physical enhancement products of any kind be used in the show hall.

In accordance with T.F.A. (Inc.) Rule No.65, the only grooming aids allowed are a brush, comb or a water dampened cloth.

What chemicals are tolerated by your exhibit(s) may cause an adverse reaction or distress in other exhibits around you.

A level playing field please or expect immediate disqualification.

If you wish to 'CLEAN-UP' an exhibit you must seek permission from the show manager and the clean-up shall be done outside of the show hall. The exhibit will only be able to re-enter the hall at the discretion of the vet or show manager.
