GOATS MAY NOT LEAVE UNTIL AFTER JUDGING AT THE SECTION COUNCILLOR'S DISCRETION.

1-Show entrants must be active and financial members of the Boer Goat Breeders Association of Australia (BGBAA) and or Boer Goat Australia (BGA) as of date of the show. 4.11.23.

2-Show classes are open to fullblood animals registered with BGBAA and/ or BGA

3-Animals will only be admitted to the show if duly entered and the entry fee paid by the closing date. 4-Animal substitutions allowed but must be for the same class.

5-Animals to be free from external parasites/lice and must not have any bald or open abscesses - inspection by steward on arrival.

6-Animals entered in any group, progeny or special class must also be entered in respective age class. 7-Age to be calculated from DOB to day of show 4th November 2023.

8-Handlers must wear neat clothes and shoes with closed in toes. No stud logos.

9-All exhibits must have NLIS compliant tag and individual animals ID tag.

10-Classes may be altered depending on numbers of entries.

11-Animal inspections from 8 am.

12-Animals to be in their allotted pens by 9am.

13-Judging to commence at 10.am. Goats must not leave until 3pm or directed by the Councillor in Charge.

The Society's 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prize ribbons will be awarded in all classes where merited. Entries will be accepted on the understanding that should they be in excess of the accommodation, the number of exhibits will be reduced accordingly. The Council of the RAST will allocate pens & exhibitors will be notified. All goats may be inspected by stewards for compliant tags. A lunch break will be taken at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

- 11. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
