**GOATS MAY NOT LEAVE UNTIL AFTER JUDGING AT
THE SECTION COUNCILLOR'S DISCRETION.**

- 1-Show entrants must be active and financial members of the Boer Goat Breeders Association of Australia (BGBAA) and or Boer Goat Australia (BGA) as of date of the show. 4.11.23.
- 2-Show classes are open to fullblood animals registered with BGBAA and/ or BGA
- 3-Animals will only be admitted to the show if duly entered and the entry fee paid by the closing date.
- 4-Animal substitutions allowed but must be for the same class.
- 5-Animals to be free from external parasites/lice and must not have any bald or open abscesses - inspection by steward on arrival.
- 6-Animals entered in any group, progeny or special class must also be entered in respective age class.
- 7-Age to be calculated from DOB to day of show 4th November 2023.
- 8-Handlers must wear neat clothes and shoes with closed in toes. No stud logos.
- 9-All exhibits must have NLIS compliant tag and individual animals ID tag.
- 10-Classes may be altered depending on numbers of entries.
- 11-Animal inspections from 8 am.
- 12-Animals to be in their allotted pens by 9am.
- 13-Judging to commence at [10.am](#). Goats must not leave until 3pm or directed by the Councillor in Charge.

The Society's 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prize ribbons will be awarded in all classes where merited. Entries will be accepted on the understanding that should they be in excess of the accommodation, the number of exhibits will be reduced accordingly. The Council of the RAST will allocate pens & exhibitors will be notified. All goats may be inspected by stewards for compliant tags. A lunch break will be taken at the discretion of the Chief Steward.

Section A - Supplier's statements about risk and duty of care

Royal Hobart Show (together the Suppliers) advise as set out below.

The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

Participation (including passive participation) in animal handling and/or physical competitions and/or Events at an agricultural show and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent.

Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers' facilities are all dangerous recreational activities. This document is a risk warning for the purpose of Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act TAS 2002. This risk warning is given by or on behalf of the Suppliers.

This document acts as an exclusion of liability under Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act (TAS) 2002 if the services supplied by the Suppliers are supplied without reasonable care and skill.

Section B - Participant's acknowledgements

By signing this document I acknowledge that:

1. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the Australian Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010 and a recreational activity for the purposes of Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act (TAS) 2002.
2. I participate in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities at my own risk.
3. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a hazardous activity and involves a significant risk of physical harm and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me and others.

8. Insects or other animals may cause animals used in the Event to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way.
9. In handling animals, there is a risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by the animals.
10. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation

of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.

11. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
12. I use the Suppliers' facilities, including for the Event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me, both obvious and inherent.
13. At the time of participating in the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities, I will not to any degree be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
14. I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities and agree that such use may result in my being excluded from the Event and/or from using the Suppliers' facilities with no entitlement to any refund of money paid to the Suppliers for entry.


