This Show will be run on the "Bay" format - thus enabling interested exhibitors to observe the judging. **The Cat Pavilion will be open to limited general public access whilst judging in progress.** Exhibits must not be removed from the show hall before the close of show.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

All Royal Hobart Show entrants are bound by all of the Policies, Procedures, Rules and Regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania. These may be amended at the discretion of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of RAST.

Registration:

The Society may only accept entries for cats which are registered with a recognised control body. Companion Pets are exempt from registration.

Entry Fees: All Entry Fees must be paid at the time of entry.

Veterinary examination:

A suitably qualified veterinary official elected by the show committee, or the R.A.S.T. (inc.), shall examine each exhibit. They shall refuse to allow any cat to enter the exhibition if, in their opinion, it is suffering from any contagious or infectious disease or has external parasites, or which has been treated or prepared for exhibition in contravention of the rules and regulations under which the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania runs this event. The veterinary officer's decision in this regard shall be final. Should the veterinary officer reject an exhibit for reasons of contagious or infectious disease or evidence of external parasites, all that exhibitor's entries may be rejected at the discretion of the veterinary officer. No person may present an exhibit which has been exposed to the risk of any infectious or contagious disease during the period dating at least 12 days prior to the exhibition. It is expected that all exhibits should have appropriate immunisations prior to the show.

Benching:

Curtains are allowed during judging and, if required, a hot water bottle completely enclosed. Litter trays to be preferably plastic and rectangular in shape. No foodstuffs are allowed in cages before completion of judging. Cages must be kept clean by exhibitors. One small toy per cage is permissible.

Withdrawal of entries:

Entries may be withdrawn-no refund unless approved by RAST.

Judging:

At the time of judging no person shall be allowed in the judging area save the judges and the properly appointed officials and stewards.

A judge's decision on the merit of the exhibit shall be final unless such decision is contrary to the rules and regulations under which the RAST show is held. Judges are empowered and instructed not to award any prize, challenge or award certificate to any exhibit which they consider is not of sufficient an award. Any exhibit which cannot be taken from its cage by the judge or steward will not be judged.

Owner's risk:

The care and safety of all exhibits, or any other property entrusted to it, is of the utmost importance to the RAST. However it must be understood that the RAST will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any exhibit or property, whether arising from accident, or other cause whatsoever, or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents servants or others.

Exhibits claws:

All Exhibits must have **clipped claws**, clean ears and coats free from pests. Strict attention must be paid to this rule. Claws are not to be clipped within the show hall. **THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED**

SHOW CLASSES

KITTEN CLASSES - Entire & desexed Exhibits 10 weeks and under 9 mths on the day of show. **All kittens must have a registration number with recognised Association to compete**, no entries will be accepted as “pending”. If you are waiting for registrations to be returned from your Registrar – please advise the Show Secretary at the time of entry. **Kittens under the age of ten (10) weeks may not be exhibited.**

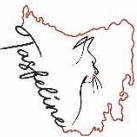

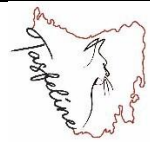

Section A - Supplier's statements about risk and duty of care

Royal Hobart Show (together the Suppliers) advise as set out below.

The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

Participation (including passive participation) in animal handling and/or physical competitions and/or Events at an agricultural show and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent.

Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers' facilities are all dangerous recreational activities. This document is a risk warning for the purpose of Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act TAS 2002. This risk warning is given by or on behalf of the Suppliers.

This document acts as an exclusion of liability under Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act (TAS) 2002 if the services supplied by the Suppliers are supplied without reasonable care and skill.

Section B - Participant's acknowledgements

By signing this document I acknowledge that:

1. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the Australian Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010 and a recreational activity for the purposes of Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act (TAS) 2002.
2. I participate in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities at my own risk.
3. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a hazardous activity and involves a significant risk of physical harm and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me and others.

8. Insects or other animals may cause animals used in the Event to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way.
9. In handling animals, there is a risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by the animals.
10. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation

of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.

11. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
12. I use the Suppliers' facilities, including for the Event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me, both obvious and inherent.
13. At the time of participating in the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities, I will not to any degree be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
14.
