The Society's 1st, 2nd & 3rd Prize ribbons will be awarded in all classes where merited. Entries will be accepted on the understanding that should they be in excess of the accommodation, the number of exhibits will be reduced accordingly. The Council of the RAST will allocate pens & exhibitors will be notified. All goats may be inspected by stewards for tattoos prior to judging.
