Where's the Show?

The Hobart Showground continues to undergo a major redevelopment and the Show will this year again run across the successful multi-venue format of 2023: the Hobart Regatta Grounds and nearby Goods Shed, and Hobart City Hall. One ticket will cover all venues!

Limited parking is available at the Regatta Grounds, including priority parking for people with disabled parking permits and the elderly. There is a drop-off zone for showgoers, and of course, close by are car parks and street parking.

The drop-off zone can be accessed via McVilly Drive and the location is marked on the Show map.

Elsewhere:

Tasmanian Equestrian Centre at Lauderdale hosts the big Show Equestrian program Thursday 24 October to Saturday 26 October.

Campbell Town Showground hosts the Stud Sheep and Goat judging on November 2.

These other locations are free if showgoers wish to attend.

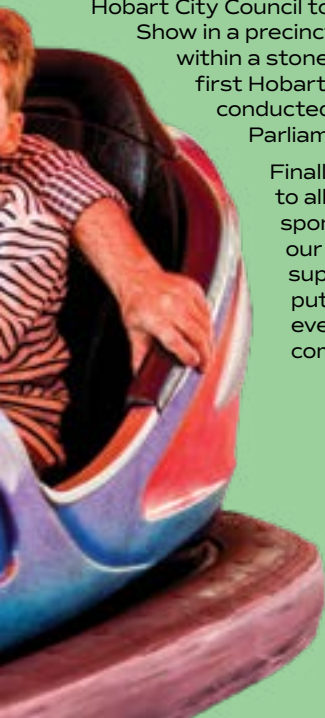

THE REGATTA GROUNDS BECOME THE SHOWGROUND

This is the third year that the Royal Hobart Show has been centred on the Regatta Grounds while it builds a completely new Showground at Glenorchy.

Did you know that the Show has had many temporary homes in Hobart since the first Show was held in Salamanca Place in 1822!

In the 1800's there were shows in the Hobart Town Hall, at Elwick racecourse, Bridgewater, and on land on New Town Road, until the RAST purchased 16ha of bushland at Elwick as a permanent home for the Show in 1903.

Now known as the Showground, that land is under redevelopment with an ultra-modern new arena and sophisticated pavilion under planning approval as the home of the Show for at least the next 100 years.

The Regatta Grounds make a great temporary substitution, together with Hobart City Hall, and the Goods Shed where cattle and cat judging take place.

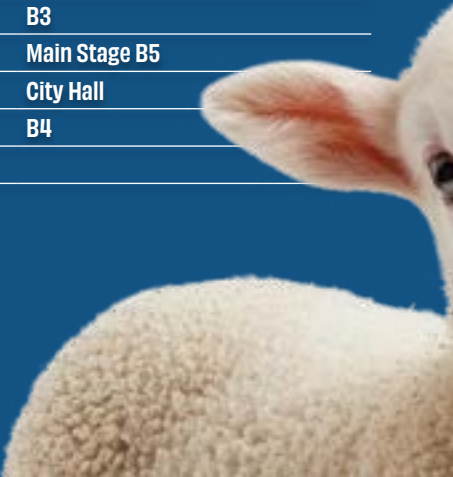

AN ALPHABET OF ENTERTAINMENT

REGATTA GROUNDS, CITY HALL & GOODS SHED

Alpacas (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - A4

A native of South America, the alpaca is a domesticated member of the Camelid family which includes the llama, camel, dromedary, guanaco and vicuna. Did you know that Australia has the largest population of alpacas outside of South America?

The Toffeemont Alpacas will be on display at this year's Show.

Artery Art on Show (City Hall)

This is one of the biggest annual art exhibitions in Tasmania, open to amateurs and professionals alike. The Royal Hobart 'Artery Art on Show' attracts more than 150 entries each year.

The art reflects the creative skills of the Tasmanian community. A wide range of traditional and abstract styles will be on display covering works in oil, acrylic, water colour, mixed media and pastel. Prize money of more than \$10,000 is awarded thanks to the generosity of Artery.

Bakesale Creative Crafts (City Hall)

One of the traditions of the Royal Hobart Show is the Creative Crafts Section.

Creative Crafts is a large section and a central focus of the Show. It aims to recognise people in our community who are doing great creative things: from culinary arts to jewellery making, knitting, crochet, embroidery, recycling and repurposing, and much more.

We will have several exhibitors running demonstrations at City Hall including Candle making, Cake decorating, Spinning and weaving throughout the Show. Check out the program for times and details.

Betta® Milk Dairy Cattle (24-26 October at The Goods Shed)

Dairying is another major Australian rural industry in which production significantly exceeds domestic requirements and Australia has emerged as one of the world's major exporters of dairy products.

The history of Australian dairying dates back to the arrival of the First Fleet in 1788. The early

dual-purpose Shorthorn cattle and goats provided the fledgling colony with much of its milk and meat needs.

Beef Cattle (24-26 October at the Goods Shed)

Cattle first came to Australia with the First Fleet in 1788. They did poorly in the tough Australian conditions so different breeds from Europe, including Shorthorn and Hereford, were transported to Australia to improve quality.

The Young Beef Cattle judging will take place on Thursday and the Young Beef Cattle Handling competition will take place on Saturday.

Fairbrother Friday Night Entertainment (Regatta Grounds)

Friday night at the Show has been a family tradition for many years and this year's program is sure to have something for everyone. All the Show's entertainment offerings will be performing, and the night ends with a massive fireworks display over the city.

Friday night is a great time to visit the Show. The fireworks extravaganza starts at 9.00pm. If you are one of the many who like to take to the water to see the fireworks from offshore, be aware that for safety reasons a boating exclusion zone will be in force.

Fleece Display (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - B4 (Located beneath the grandstand)

The Fleece competition is a showcase of wool from all parts of Tasmania. Feel the different types of wool and find out what makes a good fleece. There is a display of wool spinning and some finely crafted and colourful woollen hand-made products.

The best fleeces in Tasmania will be on display along with some samples that you can take home with you.

Food Hub (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - C3/B4

A family friendly hub on the lawn opposite the Showbags. Plenty of traditional show fare food as well as a selection of Hobart's finest street eats.

With seating in the grandstand or on the lawns close by, head to the Food Hub for all your food needs while you're visiting this year's Show at the Regatta Grounds.

At the Food Hub this year you will find woodfired pizzas, kebabs, burgers, coffees and much more!

Howrah Plumbing Woodchopping (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - A5/B5

Woodchopping is always one of the most exciting competitions on the Showground and this year will be no different! The Howrah Plumbing Woodchopping competition will run throughout the Show and is always a fascinating watch for anyone attending the Show.

Tasmania has a proud heritage in this exciting sport. This year, the woodchop arena is located near the southern end of the Regatta Grounds, close to the waterfront.

There will be a full program of activities over three days from Thursday including men's, women's and team events.

Interactive Activities Hub (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref A4/A5/B4

The Activities Hub is back this year and will operate throughout the Show. It will play host to Cricket Tasmania and the Hobart Hurricanes who will provide opportunities to work on your bowling and batting skills.

There is also the enjoyable pastime of woodworking. Through the generosity of the Woodcraft Guild of Tasmania, members will conduct woodcraft activities for children to appreciate and experience the art of woodcraft. Children will get the chance to construct a pre-fabricated item and glue, screw and nail it together, and then they can take home their handiwork.

PETstock Life on the Farm (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - C2

It's not every day that children get the chance to visit and maybe even pat lots of cute animals. Two of our most popular exhibits, Animal Nursery and Life on the Farm, have now been merged into one big area

A broad range of animals including goats, bees, lambs, and a host of other surprises await the visitor. The Life on the Farm display is an educational centre designed to introduce city folk to the role of agricultural animals. Demonstrations include sheep shearing, bee keeping, butter making and lots of free hands-on activities such as wheat grinding, digging spuds and planting tomato seeds.

Reptile Rescue (Regatta Grounds)

Located in PETstock Life on the Farm Map Ref - C2

Snakes and lizards galore! One of our most popular exhibits is back again this year. Learn about handling snakes; find out which ones are venomous and get a close up look if you dare. Educational talks and demonstrations will occur throughout each day so check our program for exact times.

Royal Canin Cat Section (24 October at the Goods Shed)

One of the most popular exhibitions at the Show. A large variety of expertly manicured and groomed felines will be on display with judging occurring on Thursday. Did you know that despite being solitary hunters, cats are a social species and cat communication includes the use of a variety of vocalizations (mewing, purring, trilling, hissing, growling and grunting), as well as cat pheromones and types of cat-specific body language.

Royal Canin Kennel Section (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - B1

Dog judging starts Thursday and continues on every day of the Show. Over 400 dogs, covering 109 different breeds from all over Australia are competing for the coveted title of "Best Dog in Show" at the Regatta Grounds. This is a major event in the canine calendar.

This year's Kennel section has attracted a renowned international judge: Mr. Daniel Ceres Rubio from Brazil.

Born in Uruguay and resident in Brazil since 1978 where he works as an architect, Daniel founded the Performance Kennels, specialising in English Cocker Spaniels. He also exhibited Boxer, Dachshund and Bernese Mountain Dogs. Over the years

he raised several national and international champions. He also regularly judges at dog shows all over the world.

Tasmanian Government Pavilion (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - B2

The Tasmanian Government returns with an interactive display covering primary industries, emergency services, health and many other areas. Come along and engage with our State's public servants, have some fun, and learn a thing or two about what our State Government does for you. The tent is jam packed with kid's activities.

Vintage Machinery and Transport (Regatta Grounds)

Map Ref - A4

One of the most visited exhibits at the Betta® Milk Royal Hobart Show, the Vintage (Heritage) Machinery and Transport areas present more than 100 individual items of vintage machinery, all of which have been integral to Tasmania's agricultural development. Come and speak to members of the Hobart Vintage Machinery Society.

Youth Art & Student Photography (City Hall)

A great space at City Hall with more room and better combination of youth art and student photography for 2024. A must see for those curious to know what Hobart's young artists are producing and those looking for inspiration from the millennials.

The Youth Art and Student Photography presentations will occur on Wednesday 23rd of October at 4.30pm at City Hall.

7HOFM Live Broadcast

7HOFM will broadcast live from the Regatta Grounds throughout the Show and will also visit our other locations throughout the event. Come and see what it takes to live broadcast on the Show's favourite radio station and meet all your favourite 7HOFM presenters.

AROUND & ABOUT

As we've mentioned elsewhere, some Show activities this year are being held around and about the central Show hubs of the Regatta Grounds, the Hobart City Hall, and the Goods Shed.

This is because of the redevelopment that's underway of the Hobart Showground. We look forward to all our activities returning to the Showground as we move ahead.

Here's a schedule of other Show activities around and about.

Equestrian competitions (24 - 26 October at Tasmanian Equestrian Centre)

More than 300 horses and ponies will compete at the Royal Hobart Show equestrian event. There are many different breeds of horse taking part as they compete for the sought after Blue Ribbon.

You can visit the Pony Club competition on Thursday October 24, the Showjumping on 25 October and then visit the other equestrian events on 26 October at the Tasmanian Equestrian Centre, located at Lauderdale. Entry into the venue is free.

Roberts Insurance Providers Goats and Sheep Show (2 November at Campbell Town Showground)

Goats

RAST is very proud to be taking the Goats judging to the beautiful Campbell Town Showground again this year: a great venue for the animals while we await the completion of the Hobart Showground redevelopment.

This is a free event for the public.

Stud Sheep

Sheep judging will be held at the Campbell Town Showground on 2 November. After that, it's time for them to go back to pasture.

The Royal Hobart Show presents many different breeds of sheep, most bred for a specific purpose (either wool or meat).

Entry for the public to visit our Sheep and Goat competitions at Campbell Town is free so please come along for a look!

ATM Facilities at the Regatta Grounds

This year you will find an ATM located next to the Waterside Gate.

Toilet Facilities

There are numerous toilet facilities located around the Regatta Grounds and at City Hall. Please refer to the map for specific locations at the Regatta Grounds or see our volunteers at City Hall for directions.

First Aid

You will find the St Johns First Aid Marquee behind the Main Grandstand. In case of an emergency contact Show staff, Security or Police.

Lost Persons Centre

If a child under your care becomes lost, please report immediately to the RAST Show centre, located under the main grandstand at the Regatta Grounds, or speak to a member of Show Staff or Security who will be able to help you. A good idea is to show your child the location of the centre and advise them to go there if you become separated.

Lost Property - take to Admin

If you find any lost property, please hand this into the Show Office located under the Main Grandstand or hand to a member of security.

What to Bring

- Sunscreen and hat
- Water (Free water is available onsite near the Main Grandstand)
- Wet weather gear
- Comfortable shoes

Getting to the Show

Metro:

Check the online Metro timetables for regular services to the Regatta Grounds, City Hall or the Goods Shed.

Parking arrangements:

Limited parking is available at the Regatta Grounds, including priority parking for people with disabled parking permits and the elderly. There is a drop-off zone for showgoers, and of course, close by are car parks and street parking.

The drop-off zone can be accessed via McVilly Drive and the location is marked on the Show map.

Disabled Parking

Limited Disabled Parking is located in the carpark off McVilly Drive next to the Main Gate. You will find the location for this on the Show Map.

Bicycles: Bring a security device to secure your bike and park it in the car park off McVilly Drive next to the disability parking area.

Animals on Display

If you are visiting the animal judging, please be aware that some breeds are not at the Show the whole time. Although many animals are domesticated, they can cause injury and should be treated with caution. The size and bulk of some animals can make them potentially very dangerous.

- Avoid quick movements or loud noises that may frighten the animals.
- Do not poke, tease or imitate the sound the animal makes.
- Beware of standing behind the animals, as livestock can kick forward, sideways and backwards.
- Only pat the animals if the owner is present and gives their permission. Wash hands afterwards.
- Move slowly in single file around livestock.
- Allow enough space between you and the animals to avoid being stepped on or kicked.

→ Most animals tend to be aggressive when protecting their young. Be extra careful around newborn animals.

→ Touch animals gently but only when allowed to do so. Don't push or shove.

→ Always wash your hands after touching animals. Facilities are located at the entry and exit points of animal pavilions.

→ Please ensure you do not feed any of the animals on site unless a Show volunteer or staff member gives you permission to do so.

Foot and Mouth Disease

For the safety of all animals, across all locations, if you have recently travelled overseas, please ensure your footwear and clothing is not the same as you used overseas or have them well cleaned prior to coming to the Betta® Milk Royal Hobart Show.

Respite Areas

The best places to sit down as a group and either eat lunch or just have a rest are:

- Main Grandstand - providing plenty of undercover seating for everyone
- Activities Hub - ideal for parents to take a seat and watch their children play cricket
- Picnic seating is available all around the grounds.
- Bar - the Show bar is available upstairs in the Main Grandstand and is open for all Showgoers.

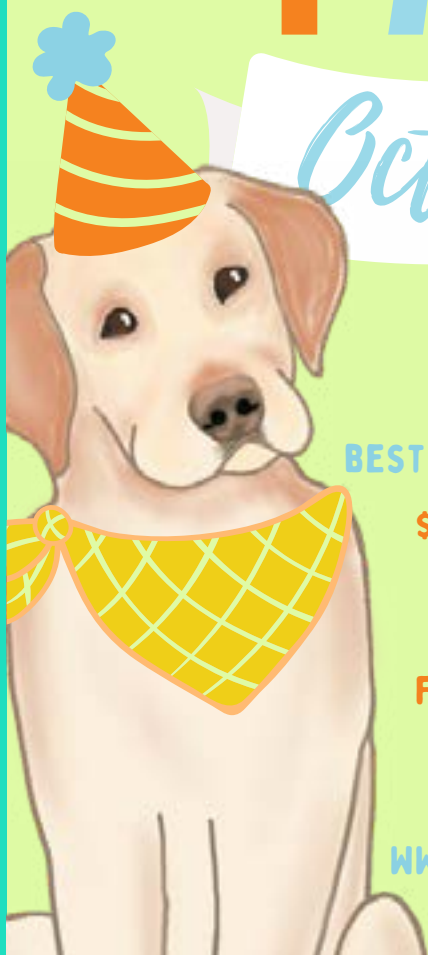
