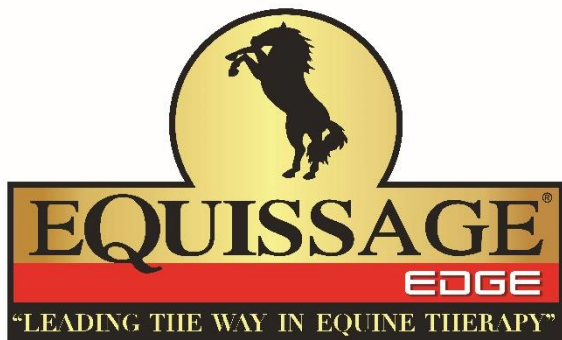

GENERAL REGULATIONS

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By entering this competition, exhibitors agree to comply with these terms and conditions and the rules, regulations and policies of the RAST ('Rules'). Upon submission of an entry, the exhibitor agrees to be bound by the Rules and to ensure that his or her family, invitees and agents also comply with the Rules and follow all directions of Ground Staff during the competition.

The Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania ('RAST' or 'Society') reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason. Exhibitors entering their horses do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its Council Officers, Officials or Members in any respect whatsoever, other than the liability for refund of entry fees in the event of abandonment of any competition.

Where an exhibit, exhibitor and/or an agent fails to comply with any of the Rules, RAST may impose one or more of the following penalties on them: (d) disqualification; (e) suspension; (f) a fine; (g) order the exhibit or the exhibitor, his or her family, invitees and agents be removed from the showgrounds; or (h) any other penalty. Without limiting the above, RAST may forfeit an award.

REGISTRATION OF HORSES

All Exhibits entered in ridden sections must be registered with any Australian or Internationally recognised breed society, Show Horse Council Australia, Equestrian Australia, Australian Stud Book or registered on the National Saddle Horse Register.

MEASURING

All horses entered for this event must have a current height certificate issued in Tasmania by EA Tasmania or Show Horse Council Tasmania measurers. Height certificates must be carried at all times whilst competing.

SUBSTITUTION OF HORSES

An exhibitor may withdraw any or all of their horses from a competition but may not add a horse that has **not** been entered for that competition without the approval of the Committee.

HORSE AGE

The age of horses is to date from 1 August in each year. Every horse foaled before 1 August in any year shall be deemed to be one year old on that date.

HORSE CLASSIFICATION

Exhibits can be shown in either the Show Hunter OR the Show Horse section. The same exhibit cannot be entered in both sections.

RIDER AGE

Rider age for Leading Rein competitors and all riding classes is at the date of the date of the show.

LEADING REIN

3 years to 7 years. Snaffle bridle only. Attendant must affix the leading rein to the noseband, the reins should go directly to the child's hand, string not permitted, or any aid fastened to the saddle to keep the pony's head in position. No spurs or whips, handler may carry a cane. Riders should at least be able to rise to the trot. Ponies must not exceed 12hh.

FIRST RIDDEN

No spurs or whips permitted. Snaffle bridle only. Riders must be 5 and under 12 years of age. Ponies must be over 12hh and not exceed 12.2hh.

NOVICE

Novices are exhibits or competitors, as is appropriate for the relevant class, who have not won a first place award at a Royal Show.

OFF THE TRACK SERIES

Open to all registered Thoroughbred and Standardbred exhibits who were bred for racing, or have raced, or barrier trialled. Race name must be supplied on entry together with Microchip Numbers. Documentation verifying eligibility must be provided on request. Stallions not eligible.

Master: Horse has been retired from racing prior to October 2024 (over 2 years)

Newcomer: Open to horses retired from racing since October 2024 (2 years and under)

Tas racing OTT Animal Welfare Award: To be judged on the horse's presentation and condition, along with the handler's horsemanship, focusing on the harmony between horse and handler, their connection, and the handler's competence in managing various situations.

COMBINING OF CLASSES

The RAST reserves the right to combine classes, vary conditions and alter classes as it sees fit. The judge will also have the right to transfer entries from one class to another.

PLACINGS & PRIZEMONEY

RAST ribbons will be awarded as follows, at the Judge's discretion: 1st - Blue, 2nd - Red, 3rd - White. All first-place winners are eligible for the Champion and Reserve Champion award within their section, (unless otherwise stated). The exhibit that places second to the Champion class is eligible for Reserve Champion. All Champions receive \$20 prize money.

JUDGE'S AUTHORITY

Judges may send off a horse which, in their opinion, is unfit to be entered in the class being judged. Exhibitors are not to approach any judge without prior approval from that judge's steward or the Chief Steward except during the conduct of a class.

ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

Riders must be suitably attired at all times while on the arena. Current standard approved helmets/hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted, unless specifically exempted for a class in the show schedule. Long boots are **not** to be worn by riders under the age of 17.

SADDLERY

All saddlery and attire must be safe and properly fitted and to the standard and quality expected of a Royal Show.

EXHIBIT NUMBER

Exhibit numbers will be posted to exhibitors on acceptance of entries. Every exhibit whilst in the ring or within a marshalling area must display its exhibit number. Ridden exhibits are to display their exhibit number either in a correctly fitted breast plate on the exhibit or conspicuously on the rider.

SWABBING

Random swabbing may be undertaken during the show, conducted in accordance with RAST requirements. It is a condition of entry you comply with any swabbing request.

PROTESTS

Protests may only be made by exhibitors with exhibits in the class to which the protest relates. Exhibitors may enter a protest by lodging it in writing at the RAST site office within 1 HOUR of the completion of the event to which the protest relates. Protests must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50. The RAST Rules and Committee will consider the protest as soon as practicable and will advise the exhibitor of its decision. If a protest is upheld, the deposit will be returned to the exhibitor. The decision of the Committee is final.

REFUNDS

Entry fees will not be refunded other than in exceptional cases and where a veterinary certificate is supplied. A refund, less 25% administration fee, will be at the discretion of the Equestrian Committee. All applications under these conditions must be received at the RAST office by Tuesday of the week following the Royal Hobart Show. This ruling will not apply where entries are not accepted by the RAST.

HORSE CONTROL

Any horse which in the opinion of the Chief Steward is not under adequate control will be sent off the arena.

MANURE

All manure is to be picked up from horse area and yards. Failure to do so may result in a fine to the exhibitor.

LUNGING

Lunging is not allowed on any part of the arena or grassed area at any time prior or during the Show. An area will be marked out for lunging and warming up.

HORSES ON THE ARENA

Only those horses competing on the day are permitted on the arena while events are underway.

DOGS

Dogs are not permitted on the ground **AT ANY TIME**. Offending persons will be asked to leave the grounds.

UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

RAST is committed to providing a fair and equitable venue for all participants, free from all forms of harassment, victimisation, discrimination, bullying and violence. Persons breaching acceptable standards of behaviour may be removed from the grounds and banned from entering future RAST events and/or the venue.

ANIMAL WELFARE

No cruelty will be tolerated. Exhibitors must familiarise themselves with the RAST policies which can be found at <https://www.hobartshowground.com.au/policies>

COLLECTION & USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

The Society collects personal information from exhibitors in competitions conducted by the Society. Verification of the accuracy of this data may be obtained through contact with the RAST. This information is used only for the purpose related to the conduct of the events run by the Society and is not divulged to third parties. However, entrant's names and contact details may be released to duly authorised parties in respect to matters of animal health and safety. The names of exhibitors may be included in catalogues published by the Society and

successful exhibitors' names released for general publication. If you do not provide the information requested on the competition entry form, we may not be able to accept your entry.

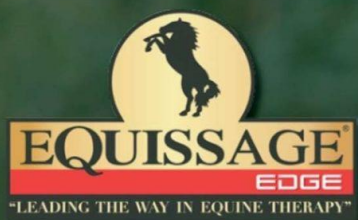
