The Hobart Showground is currently undergoing a major redevelopment and the Show will this year again run across the successful multi-venue format of 2022: the Hobart Regatta Grounds and Hobart City Hall with the addition this year of The Goods Shed at Macquarie Point. One Show ticket will get you into the Hobart Regatta Grounds but all other venues are free to visit!

Elsewhere:

Tasmanian Equestrian Centre at Lauderdale hosts the big Show Equestrian program Thursday 26 October – Saturday 28 October.

Campbell Town Showground hosts the Stud Sheep and Goat judging on November 4.

These other locations are free if showgoers wish to attend.

THE REGATTA GROUNDS BECOME THE SHOWGROUND

The Royal Hobart Show has had many temporary homes in Hobart since the first Show was held in Salamanca Place in 1822.

In the 1800's there were shows in the Hobart Town Hall, at Elwick race course, Bridgewater, and on land on New Town Road, until the RAST purchased 16ha of bushland at Elwick as a permanent home for the Show in 1903.

Now known as the Showground, that land is under redevelopment with an ultra modern new arena and sophisticated pavilion due to be ready for the 2025 Royal Hobart Show.

While construction continues, this is the second year that the Show has been held in multiple locations with the Regatta Grounds and Hobart City Hall forming the hub of activities. This year, The Goods Shed at nearby Macquarie Point comes on board for the cattle and cat judging.

Meanwhile, the modern reimagination of the Showground will ensure the Show continues as Australia's oldest agricultural show for the next 200 years, and you will be delighted by what you see when you come to your first Show at the Showground in 2025.

Meet the Entertainers at the 2023 PETstock Royal Hobart Show

Great entertainment is a hall mark of the Royal Hobart Show. This year, check the daily programs here in the Mag, or online, to make sure you don't miss a thing.

Outback Stockman Show (Animal Wranglers)

The Show has secured The Outback Stockman Show as a major entertainment act. These Animal Wranglers were a big hit last time they were at the Show in 2017, giving showgoers a taste of amazing Outback horsemanship skills.

Yackandandah boy Lachie Cossor, who specialises in horse handling and education will showcase his skills in wrangling everything from bulls and goats to horses. It's a great agricultural experience for people of all ages and provides plenty of "wow" moments.

Jet Pack Entertainment

Gold Coast based Jetpack Entertainment came to the Show last year and was so well received we're bringing the act back again this year. Using entertainment technology such as jet skis and jet packs, it's a fast moving experience that at times seems to defy gravity. Lots of water, lots of light, and what's that flying through the air? Surely it's not a person?

Eljay's Junkyard Action Show

Eljay Driessens will be at the Show this year. As Brisbane's Courier Mail put it: "Eljay isn't your normal stunt bike show – it's a performance of crazy, gravitydefying stunts that never fails to captivate audiences Australiawide".

Eljay started riding in motorcycle and bicycle trials at the age of 11. By 14, he was competing in A Grade competitions across Australia. He's competed in the European and world championship circuits and his Eljay Show has evolved into one of Australia's most respected and entertaining motorcycle and bicycle stunt shows.

Noah's Thoroughbred Racing Pigs

Back at the Show this year from Queensland, Noah's Racing Pigs are simply adored by children. It's sheer entertainment for everyone.

From the race call, through the obstacles, to the last snout in the finishing trough, crowds can't get enough of their antics. Noah's Thoroughbred Racing Pigs have been entertaining Australians for over a decade, travelling all over Queensland, New South Wales & Victoria. And they're always in hot demand at the Royal Hobart Show.

Sea Shanty Circus

Sea Shanties are work songs performed by sailors as they went about the daily tasks onboard sailing ships. Now they're coming to the Show courtesy of Sea Shanty Circus.

This is a unique interactive musical experience. With over 40 years combined experience in performing, Shannon, Mark and Felicity create their own world for their audiences. Experience them roving around at the Show. Sea shanties, circus, theatre and fun. It's all there.

Pandara Kelpies

Matthew Johnson demonstrates how intelligent and well trained his yard dogs are around the farm. This show provides an insight into how working dogs make such a difference on a farm. They will be visiting the Show from Thursday to Saturday.

Brian Fish's Bullock Team

In the days before tractors and heavy machinery animals were used to do all of the heavy lifting. This included heavy horses and bullocks. Brian Fish is keeping the tradition alive and is a wealth of information about these magnificent beasts and their contribution to the early colony.

Crazy Daisy the Clown

Crazy Daisy will be roving at this year's Royal Hobart Show. She's a big crowd pleaser, using her skills in hoops, juggling and acrobatics to keep the audience cheering, while her trained skills in traditional clowning and mime keep them laughing.

Reptile Rescue

Reptile Rescue is back this year with snakes and lizards galore. Learn all about reptile handling and even get a close up look. This year everyone's favourite reptile demonstrations will be heading to Life on the Farm, see program for times.

AN ALPHABET OF ENTERTAINMENT REGATTA GROUNDS, CITY HALL & GOODS SHED

Alpacas (Regatta Grounds) Map ref - A4

A native of South America, the alpaca is a domesticated member of the Camelid family which includes the llama, camel, dromedary, guanaco and vicuna. Did you know that Australia has the largest population of alpacas outside of South America?

The Toffeemont Alpacas will be on display at this years Royal Hobart Show!

Artery Art on Show (City Hall)

This is one of the biggest annual art exhibitions in Tasmania, open to amateurs and professionals alike. The Royal Hobart 'Artery Art on Show' attracts more than 150 entries each year.

The art reflects the creative skills of the Tasmanian community. A wide range of traditional and abstract styles will be on display covering works in oil, acrylic, water colour, mixed media and pastel. Prize money of more than \$10,000 is awarded thanks to the generosity of Artery.

Beef Cattle (26/27 October at the Goods Shed)

Cattle first came to Australia with the First Fleet in 1788. They did poorly in the tough Australian conditions so different breeds from Europe, including Shorthorn and Hereford, were transported to Australia to improve quality.

The Junior Beef Cattle Judging will take place on Thursday afternoon and the Junior Beef Cattle Handling competition will take place on Friday morning.

Fairbrother Friday Night Entertainment (Regatta)

from 5.00pm Friday Night

Friday Night at the Show has been a family tradition for many years and this year's program is sure to have something for everyone.

All the Show's entertainment offerings will be performing, and the night ends with a massive fireworks display over the city. Friday night really is the ideal time to visit the Show!

The night ends with the fireworks at 9.30pm. Note for people taking to the water to see the fireworks from off shore that for safety reasons a boating exclusion zone will be in force.

Fleece Display (Regatta Grounds) Map Ref - B4 (Located

underneath the Grandstand).

The Fleece competition is a showcase of wool from all parts of Tasmania. Feel the different types of wool and find out what makes a good fleece.

The best fleeces in Tasmania will be on display along with some samples that you can take home with you.

Food Hub (Regatta Grounds) Map Ref - C3/B4

A family friendly hub on the lawn opposite the Showbags. Plenty of traditional show fare food as well as a selection of Hobart's finest street eats.

With seating in the grandstand or on the lawns close by, head to the Food Hub for all your food needs while you're visiting this year's Show at the Regatta Grounds.

Four Roses Creative Crafts (City Hall)

One of the traditions of the Royal Hobart Show is the Creative Crafts Section.

Creative Crafts is a large section and a central focus of the Show. It aims to recognise people in our community who are doing great creative things: from culinary arts to jewellery making, knitting, crochet, embroidery, recycling and repurposing, and much more.

Interactive Activities Hub (Regatta Grounds) Map Ref - A4/A5

The Activities Hub is back this year, and will operate throughout the Show. It will this year play host to Cricket Tasmania and the Hobart Hurricanes who will provide opportunities to work on your bowling and batting skills.

There is also the enjoyable pastime of woodworking. Through the generosity of the Woodcraft Guild of Tasmania, members will conduct woodcraft activities for children to appreciate and experience the art of woodcraft. Children will get the chance to construct a prefabricated item and glue, screw and nail it together, and then they can take home their handiwork.

Petstock Life on the Farm (Regatta Grounds) *Map Ref - C2*

It's not every day that children get the chance to visit and maybe even pat lots of cute animals. Two of our most popular exhibits, Animal Nursery and Life on the Farm, have been merged into one this year. In fact this whole interactive exhibition is about twice the size of last year.

A broad range of animals including goats, bees, lambs and a host of other surprises await the visitor. The Life on the Farm display is an educational centre designed to introduce city folk to the role of agricultural animals. Demonstrations include sheep shearing, bee keeping, chook washing, butter making and lots of free hands-on activities such as wheat grinding, digging spuds and planting tomato seeds.

Reptile Rescue (Regatta Grounds) Located in Petstock Life on the Farm, Map Ref - C2

Snakes and lizards galore! One of our most popular exhibits is back again this year. Learn about handling snakes; find out which ones are venomous, and get a close up look if you dare. Educational talks and demonstrations will occur throughout each day so check our program for exact times.

Royal Canin Cat Section (28 October at the Goods Shed)

One of the most popular exhibitions at the Show. A large variety of expertly manicured and groomed felines will be on display with judging occurring on Saturday. Did you know that despite being solitary hunters, cats are a social species and cat communication includes the use of a variety of vocalizations (mewing, purring, trilling, hissing, growling and grunting), as well as cat pheromones and types of catspecific body language.



Royal Canin Kennel Section (Regatta Grounds) Map Ref - B1

Dog judging starts 9.30am Wednesday and continues on every day of the Show. Over 400 dogs, covering 109 different breeds from all over Australia are competing for the coveted title of "Best Dog in Show" at the Regatta Grounds. This is a major event in the canine calendar.

This year the Show's Kennel section has attracted a renowned judge, Rony Doedijns, all the way from the Netherlands. Rony has been involved in the dog world for the last 40 years, When he was 15, he got his first pedigree dog, a Finnish Spitz male puppy, and then became a breeder of the Finnish Spitz.

Rony has judged in most of European countries as well as the UK, Canada, Scandinavia, Asia, Australia, New Zealand, South America, South Africa, Russia, and USA.

Tasmanian Government Pavilion (Regatta Grounds) *Map Ref - C3*

The Tasmanian Government returns with an interactive display covering primary industries, emergency services, health and many other areas. Come along and engage with our State's professional public servants, have some fun, and learn a thing or two about what our State Government does for you. The tent is jam packed with kid's activities.

Vintage Cars (Regatta Grounds) *Map Ref - A4*

Always a favourite these old time cars will this year be located next to the Vintage Machinery display and are always a must visit at the Show for everyone to be able to see and reminisce over cars from yesteryear.

Vintage Machinery and Transport (Regatta Grounds) *Map Ref - A4*

One of the most visited exhibits at the PETstock Royal Hobart Show, the Vintage (Heritage) Machinery and Transport areas present more than 100 individual items of vintage machinery, all of which have been integral to Tasmania's agricultural development. Come and speak to members of the Hobart Vintage Machinery Society.

Woodchopping (Regatta Grounds) Map Ref - A5/B5

Entries are up this year and it doesn't get more Australian than this.

Tasmania has a proud heritage in this exciting sport. This year, the woodchop arena is located near the southern end of the Regatta Grounds, close to the waterfront.

There will be a full program of activities over three days from Thursday including men's, women's and team events.

Youth Art & Student Photography - City Hall

A great space at City Hall with more room and better combination of youth art and student photography for 2023. A must see for those curious to know what Hobart's young artists are producing and those looking for inspiration from the millennials.

A major feature of the Youth Art & Student Photography section this year will be our Black & White Photography competition. This highly popular competition is a must enter for any student looking to publicly exhibit their photos for the first time. Check out the Youth Art & Student Photography section for further details.

7HOFM Live Broadcast Thursday, Friday and Saturday at the Regatta Grounds

7HOFM will this year be broadcasting live from our city locations throughout the event. Come and see what it takes to live broadcast on the Show's favourite radio station. Keep an eye out throughout the Show for the chance to meet Sarah, Mick and Johnno.

ATM Facilities at the Regatta Grounds

This year you will find an ATM located next to the Main Gate.

Toilet Facilities

There are numerous toilet facilities located around the Regatta Grounds and at City Hall. Please refer to the map for specific locations at the Regatta Grounds or see our volunteers at City Hall for directions.

First Aid

You will find the St Johns First Aid Marquee next to the Main Grandstand. In case of an emergency contact Show staff, Security or Police.

Lost Persons Centre

If a child under your care becomes lost, please report immediately to the RAST Show centre, located under the main grandstand at the Regatta Grounds, or speak to a member of Show Staff or Security who will be able to help you. A good idea is to show your child the location of the centre and advise them to go there if you become separated.

Lost Property - take to Admin

If you find any lost property, please hand this in to the Show Office located under the Main Grandstand or hand to a member of security.

What to Bring

- ➔ Water (Free water is available onsite near the Main Grandstand)

Getting to the Show

Metro: Check the online Metro timetables for regular services to the Regatta Grounds, City Hall or the Hobart Showground

Parking arrangements: Limited parking is available at Macquarie Point. Parking is \$10 and is open to all Showgoers, no matter the location you are visiting.

Disabled Parking: Limited Disabled Parking is located in the carpark off McVilly Drive next to the Main Gate. You will find the location for this on the Show Map.

Bicycles: Bring a security device to secure your bike and park it in the car park off McVilly Drive next to the disability parking area.

Scooters: This year the PETstock Royal Hobart Show has partnered with Neuron Scooters. You will find an abundance of Scooters near the entries to the Regatta Grounds and City Hall. Please jump on a scooter to travel between the locations but remember to Scoot Safe!

Animals on Display

If you are visiting the animal judging, please be aware that some breeds are not at the Show the whole time. Although many animals are domesticated, they can cause injury and should be treated with caution. The size and bulk of some animals can make them potentially very dangerous.

- Avoid quick movements or loud noises that may frighten the animals.
- Do not poke, tease or imitate the sound the animal makes.
- Beware of standing behind the animals, as livestock can kick forward, sideways and backwards.
- Only pat the animals if the owner is present and gives their permission.
 Wash hands afterwards.
- Move slowly in single file around livestock.

- Allow enough space between you and the animals to avoid being stepped on or kicked.
- Most animals tend to be aggressive when protecting their young. Be extra careful around newborn animals.
- Touch animals gently but only when allowed to do so. Don't push or shove.
- Always wash your hands after touching animals. Facilities are located at the entry and exit points of animal pavilions.

Foot and Mouth Disease

For the safety of all animals, across all locations, if you have recently travelled overseas, please ensure your footwear and clothing is not the same as you used overseas, or have them well cleaned prior to coming to the PETstock Royal Hobart Show.

Respite Areas

The best places to sit down as a group and either eat lunch or just have a rest are:

- Main Grandstand providing plenty of undercover seating for everyone
- Activities Hub ideal for parents to take a seat and watch their children play cricket






